Dear Artists Showcase West Subscriber:

We look forward to seeing you at our final concert on Sunday, June 3, at 3:00 p.m. This free concert features the Ariel Quartet with special guest pianist Menahem Pressler. Please feel free to invite family, friends and neighbors to come and also enjoy this festive performance by internationally acclaimed artists. No ticket is required to attend this free, final "Thank you!" concert.

Unfortunately, because of construction activities at the North High School, our usual parking lot east of Main Street will not be available to concert goers this coming Sunday. As indicated in our letter in April, we have identified several other available parking locations. These parking arrangements are shown in the attached figure.

1. The West High School Parking Lot between Prince St and Saratoga Ave, just south of Sherman St, which is one way - west bound - between Main St and Prince St.
2. The Township Parking Lot on the north side of Sherman St between Prince St and Saratoga Ave.
3. The South High School Parking Lot that is accessed from Forest Ave with the exit onto Main St. A number of the spaces in this South Lot are reserved for Handicapped Parking. A door on the south side of the High School building will be open for entrance by handicapped individuals and people who are dropped off on Forest Ave at the south side of the School.
4. On street parking east of Main St on Highland Ave and Sherman St.

Because no entrance will be open for us on the west side of the School, if you park in the West Parking Lot or the Township Parking Lot, you need to walk around to the front entrance of the School (a distance of about three blocks).

Please leave a bit of extra time to park and walk to the High School entrance. The pre-concert talk will begin as usual at 2:00 p.m. with the concert starting at 3:00 p.m. If you have friends who you think may want to attend this free, final concert, please help us by informing them about the unusual parking situation. We are extremely sorry for these awkward parking arrangements, but we hope that the exceptional quality of our final concert may provide a suitable compensating reward.
